GENE A. JAMES, OF RICHMOND, VA., HAS ACHIEVED REMARKABLE PROFESSIONAL SUCCESS AND HAS PLAYED A PROMINENT ROLE IN VIRGINIA AGRICULTURE. AFTER GRADUATING FROM VIRGINIA TECH IN 1953, HE EMBARKED ON A 43-YEAR CAREER WITH SOUTHERN STATES COOPERATIVE, THE LAST 17 OF WHICH HE SERVED AS PRESIDENT AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER. NEVER FORGETTING HIS TIES TO HIS ALMA MATER, JAMES HAS TIRELESSLY SERVED THE UNIVERSITY IN NUMEROUS CAPACITIES OVER THE YEARS. "MR. JAMES EMBODIES THE MOTTO OF OUR UNIVERSITY: UT PROSIM, 'THAT I MAY SERVE'," SAID FORMER PRESIDENT PAUL E. TORGERSEN. IN 1997, JAMES AND HIS WIFE, INA MAE, GENEROUSLY ESTABLISHED THE GENE A. - 2008 Interlocking Chain A tradition on Virginia Tech rings since 1940, the interlocking chain represents class pride and unity.
- HOLTZMAN ALUMNI CENTER OPENED AND DEDICATED IN FALL 2005, THE HOLTZMAN ALUMNI CENTER IS THE NEW HOME TO THE VIRGINIA TECH ALUMNI ASSOCIATION. THIS IS THE FIRST APPEARANCE OF THE HOLTZMAN ALUMNI CENTER ON A VIRGINIA TECH CLASS RING.
- THE NEW RIVER DESPITE ITS NAME, THE RIVER IS CONSIDERED BY GEOLOGISTS TO BE ONE OF THE OLDEST RIVERS IN THE WORLD, SECOND IN AGE TO THE NILE RIVER AND THUS THE OLDEST IN NORTH AMERICA. LIKE THE NILE, THE NEW RIVER FLOWS IN A GENERALLY NORTHERN COURSE.
- BEAT UVA "BEAT UVA" IS A TRADITIONAL SLOGAN THAT HAS BEEN INCLUDED ON VIRGINIA TECH RINGS FOR MANY YEARS.
- MARCHING VIRGINIANS FOR 32 YEARS THE MARCHING VIRGINIANS HAVE BEEN KEEPING THE SPIRIT OF TECH ALIVE AT ALL HOME FOOTBALL GAMES AND LEADING EVERYONE IN THE HOKEF POKIF
- DOWNTOWN BLACKSBURG FOUNDED IN 1798 ON A THIRTY-EIGHT ACRE TRACT LAID OUT AND DEEDED BY WILLIAM BLACK, FOR WHOM THE TOWN WAS NAMED. DOWNTOWN BLACKSBURG SERVES AS A PLACE FOR THE VIRGINIA TECH COMMUNITY TO ENJOY LOCAL FAVORITE FOODS AND SHOPPING AS WELL AS A NIGHT-LIFE.
- HOKIEBIRD THE OFFICIAL MASCOT OF VIRGINIA TECH. THE HOKIEBIRD MADE ITS FIRST APPEARANCE IN 1987
- KEY PLAY KEYCHAIN THE KEYS HOKIEBIRD HOLDS ARE A NECESSITY FOR HOKIE FOOTBALL FANS ON EVERY 3RD DOWN OF DEFENSE SIGNIFYING A KEY PLAY.
- MOUNTAINS THE BACKDROP OF VIRGINIA TECH SCENERY IS ALWAYS THE MOUNTAINS, SITUATED ON A HIGH PLATEAU IN SOUTHWESTERN VIRGINIA BETWEEN THE BLUE RIDGE AND ALLEGHANY MOUNTAIN RANGES.

- DRILLFIELD ONE OF VIRGINIA TECH'S MOST MEMORABLE LANDMARKS ALSO CONSIDERED THE CENTER OF CAMPUS, THE DRILLFIELD HAS SERVED AS THE PATHWAY TO CLASS, SOLID GROUND FOR THE CORPS PASS AND REVIEWS, AS WELL AS THE FIELD FOR MANY STUDENTS' PLAY OR STUDY.
- ACC Logo A CENTURY LONG RIVALRY FILLED WITH INTENSITY,
 SPIRIT, AND EMOTION, THE HOO'S AND THE HOKIES FIRST FACED
 OFF IN AN 1895 FOOTBALL GAME IN CHARLOTTESVILLE, BUT THEY
 KICKED OFF FAR MORE THAN A FOOTBALL GAME THAT YEAR. THE
 TWO TEAMS FROM TWO DIFFERENT BACKGROUNDS LAUNCHED A
 GREAT TRADITION OF COMPETITIVE PLAY THAT HAS LED TO THEIR
 BEING IN THE FOREFRONT OF AMERICAN COLLEGIATE ATHLETICS.
- Lane Stadium After Remodel Now entering its 41st season as an arena of collegiate football competition, Lane Stadium/Worsham Field has gone through numerous changes, renovations and additions. But through it all, it has always been regarded as one of the finest places to watch and toughest places for opponents to play a college football game.
- "Superbia Semper, Memoria Aeternum" The Latin version of the Class of 2008 motto: "Pride Always, Tradition Forever".
- HOKIE TRACKS THE EIGHT TRACKS REPRESENTING THE EIGHT MEMBERS ON THE RING DESIGN COMMITTEE AND THE PATHWAY PAVED FROM PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE VIRGINIA TECH STUDENTS.
- FIGHTING GOBBLER AROUND 1908, TECH STUDENTS BEGAN REFERRING TO STUDENT ATHLETES AS "GOBBLER" BECAUSE OF THE WAY THEY "GOBBLED" THEIR FOOD. THOUGH THE TERM HOKIES WAS WIDELY USED, THE OFFICIAL DESIGNATION WAS ONLY CHANGED IN THE MID-1980S. A COSTUMED GOBBLER MASCOT (NOW THE HOKIEBIRD) WAS INTRODUCED DURING GAMES IN THE 1930S, AND HAS BEEN A SYMBOL OF SCHOOL SPIRIT EVER SINCE.
- HOKIE PRIDE THE POWERFUL IDENTITY AND COLLECTIVE FORCE THAT IS SHARED AND CELEBRATED BY THE HOKIE NATION.



- SCREAMING EAGLE THE SCREAMING EAGLE EVOLVED FROM A
 PAIR OF TWIN EAGLES USED ON THE FIRST VIRGINIA TECH RING,
 SYMBOLIZING THE TWIN VIRTUES OF STRENGTH AND FREEDOM.
- AMERICAN FLAG THE NATIONAL SYMBOL OF PATRIOTISM AND IDENTITY, "OLD GLORY" WAVES PROUDLY ON THE VIRGINIA TECH CAMPUS.
- CROSSED SABRES AN HONORED CORPS SYMBOL AND RING TRADITION.
- THE SKIPPER THE SKIPPER WAS THE DREAM OF 3 CADETS REALIZED IN 1964. THE SKIPPER CANNON WAS NAMED IN HONOR OF OUR FALLEN PRESIDENT, JOHN F. KENNEDY.
- Three Stars These stars honor the past, present, and future service of Tech Men and Women who defend our country's freedom.
- 1872 The year the Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College was established, later to become Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University.
- University Seal Created in 1896, the seal has, for more than ten decades, reflected the agricultural/mechanical emphasis in the Virginia Tech curriculum during its first century.
- BURRUSS HALL THE CORNERSTONE FOR VIRGINIA TECH'S MAIN
 ADMINISTRATION BUILDING WAS LAID AT THE 1935 COMMENCEMENT.
 THE BUILDING WAS NAMED FOR THE UNIVERSITY'S EIGHTH
 PRESIDENT, JULIAN ASHBY BURRUSS, CLASS OF 1898.
- CXXXIII The Class of 2008 is the 133rd class to graduate from Virginia Tech.
- VPI IN 1896, THE NAME OF VIRGINIA AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE WAS CHANGED TO VIRGINIA POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE OR VIRGINIA TECH.
- THE PYLONS EIGHT PYLONS OF THE WAR MEMORIAL REPRESENT THE FOUNDING VALUES OF VIRGINIA TECH: BROTHERHOOD, HONOR, LEADERSHIP SACRIFICE, SERVICE, LOYALTY, DUTY AND UT PROSIM.

- THE CENOTAPH A TRIBUTE TO THE SEVEN ALUMNI WHO WERE AWARDED THE COUNTRY'S HIGHEST AWARD, THE MEDAL OF HONOR, FOR HEROICS IN COMBAT. VPI IS SECOND ONLY TO WEST POINT AND THE NAVEL ACADEMY IN ITS NUMBER OF MEDAL OF HONOR RECIPIENTS.
- VIRGINIA COMMONWEALTH FLAG BECAUSE VIRGINIA WAS THE FIRST PART OF THE COUNTRY TO BE SETTLED BY ENGLISH COLONISTS, THE STATE FLAG PROUDLY REPRESENTS VIRGINIA'S LOVE OF FREEDOM. VIRGINIA TECH STANDS AS THE COMMONWEALTH'S LAND GRANT UNIVERSITY.
- CADET VIRGINIA TECH IS ONE OF THREE MAJOR CIVILIAN
 PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES IN THE COUNTRY THAT HAS AN ESTABLISHED
 MILITARY CADET CORPS.
- "LEST WE FORGET" THIS SIMPLE STONE MONUMENT HONORS THE MEMORY OF THE VPI ALUMNI WHO DIED IN WORLD WAR I. IT IS CUSTOMARY FOR EVERY CADET, WHENEVER THEY PASS "THE ROCK" TO SALUTE IT AS A MARK OF RESPECT.
- TORGERSEN BRIDGE COMPLETED IN 2000, TORGERSEN BRIDGE, NAMED AFTER DR. PAUL TORGERSEN, VIRGINIA TECH'S 14TH PRESIDENT, CREATES A GATEWAY AT THE CAMPUS'S ENTRY FROM MAIN STREET IN BLACKSBURG.
- FLAMING VT FOR 40 YEARS, THE HOTEL COMPANY OF THE VT CORPS OF CADETS HAVE IGNITED THE FLAMES OF TRADITION AT THE HOMECOMING PEP RALLY.
- CORPS OF CADETS SEAL A GREAT SOURCE OF PRIDE TO THE VIRGINIA TECH CORPS OF CADETS, THE SEAL WAS DESIGNED BY COLONEL HARRY D. TEMPLE '34.
- "UT Prosim" The Virginia Tech motto "That I May Serve", adopted in 1896.

LENGTHS AND CONDITIONS OF GUARANTEE REGARDING DEFECTS IN MATERIAL AND WORKMANSHIP: The rings are warranted to be free of defect in workmanship and materials.

LENGTH AND SCOPE OF GUARANTEE REGARDING STONES AND STONE DECORATION: Any damaged simulated stone will be replaced at no charge regardless of the cause of damage.

CONDITIONS AND ASSOCIATED CHARGES FOR RING RESIZING AND RING ADJUSTMENTS: The ring will be resized at any time at no charge.

CONDITIONS AND ASSOCIATED CHARGES FOR REPLACEMENT OF DAMAGED RINGS: Any damaged encrusted stone will be replaced at no charge regardless of cause of damage.

CONDITIONS AND ASSOCIATED CHARGES FOR ORDERING ADDITIONAL RINGS: Additional rings may be ordered at any time. After December 31, 2008, the rings may be ordered at the prevailing price at time of order. Prevailing price will be determined according to cost of gold and stones at the time of ordering.

CONDITIONS AND ASSOCIATED CHARGES FOR CHANGES IN ACADEMIC COLLEGE DESTINATION:

A classmate who changes colleges at Virginia Tech after a ring is purchased may return the ring to be remade with proper designation at no charge.

REFUND POLICY FOR RINGS RETURNED FOR STUDENTS WHO FAIL TO GRADUATE WITH THE CLASS DESIGNATED ON THE RING: A classmate who fails to graduate with their Class may return the ring for a full refund less Class dues.

RESPONSIBILITY AND PROCEDURES FOR RESOLVING DISPUTES REGARDING THE VALIDITY OF WARRANTY CLAUSES: Disputes as to the validity of the warranty clauses will be resolved by the Ring Design Committee. With Balfour's philosophy that the customer is always right, such arbitration by the Committee should never be necessary.

CONDITIONS AND ASSOCIATED CHARGES FOR RESTORING RING FINISH: Should a classmate not be totally satisfied with his or her original choice of finish, refinishing would be completed at no charge.

CONDITIONS ON HOW REPAIRS ARE MADE, WHOM TO CONTACT, AND HOW SHIPPING RATES ARE HANDLED: Prior to graduation, service dates will be established to handle any adjustments. All shipping, handling and insurance costs will be the responsibility of Balfour during these sessions.
